Marina Rustow is the Khedouri A. Zilkha Professor of Jewish Civilization in the Near East at Princeton University and an expert in documents from the Cairo Geniza. She is a co-founder of Princeton's Manuscript, Rare Book and Archive Studies Initiative and the director of the Princeton Geniza Lab, a collaborative research project devoted to deciphering and digitizing Geniza documents. In 2020, she published *The Lost Archive: Traces of a Caliphate in a Cairo Synagogue*, which reconstructed the archival system of the Fatimid dynasty based on texts that had been reused by Jewish merchants and scribes. In 2015, she was named a MacArthur Fellow.
